



CUB SCOUTS PACK 100 CODE OF CONDUCT

Leaders and youth members of Pack 100 will work together to promote good behavior in the group, while enjoying a program packed with fun and adventure.

- All youth members agree to join in and work as a group.
- Youth members and Leaders will listen to each other respectfully.
- Youth members and Leaders will respect each other and other people's property.
- Physical Violence and fighting is strictly prohibited.
- No one will make fun of anyone else because of his or her color, religion, disabilities or abilities.
- Bullying and name-calling is forbidden.

Consequences of Unacceptable Behavior

- All youth members get a verbal "first time" warning.
- With a second warning, the youth member must "sit out" an activity. A record of the second warning will be kept.
- With a third warning, a Leader will call the youth's parents to explain the recurring problem and to set up a meeting with parents to discuss possible courses of action which may include:
 - Parental supervision of the youth member for up to 3 meetings
 - Other courses of action as mutually agreed upon between Leaders, Parents and Youth Members.

Leaders, Parents and Youth Members will work together to promote positive behavior during meetings, at home and at school.

CUB SCOUTS PACK 100 CONDUCT STATEMENT

Cub Scouting is a program based on parent/son participation. It is the policy of Pack 100 that a parent or adult family members accompany the Scout on all Pack activities. Parents will also be asked to participate in den level activities from time to time. No use of alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs is permitted while at Scout functions. In addition, the following expectations have been set with the safety and best interests of all the boys in mind.

- A. The Pack 100 Code of Conduct
 - 1.) Always be on time
 - 2.) Always wear your uniform with pride.
 - 3.) Always behave and follow instructions.
 - 4.) Always follow Akela.
 - 5.) Always DO YOUR BEST.
- B. Discipline at den meetings will be at the discretion of the den leader in accordance with the following guidelines:
 - 1.) Failure to obey a rule will result in a warning, followed by time out or removal from an activity. In cases of harmful or repetitive misbehavior, parents may be called to pick up the Scout.
 - 2.) At the den leader's discretion, parents may be required to attend den functions with their Scout.
 - 3.) Den meetings are for Scouts, their parent and leaders. Other arrangements should be made for siblings during this time.
- C. It is the duty of any uniformed adult leader of Cub Scout Pack 100 to assist in maintaining order with the Cub Scouts during any Pack function.
- D. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their non-scout children during Pack activities.
- E. Pack outings are for the enjoyment of the whole family. The following guidelines ensure that these will be conducted in a safe manner:
 - 1.) An **adult** family member must accompany the Scout on the Pack outings.
 - 2.) A **permission slip** must be turned in for each Scout.
 - 3.) Always carry **water** and snacks.
 - 4.) **Be prepared** for changeable weather and carry jackets, hats, sunscreen, sunglasses, etc.
 - 5.) **Stay** with the group.
 - 6.) **Respect wildlife** and our ecology by observing not disturbing nature.

We recognize that as a participant, we, through our actions, represent Pack 100 and the Boy Scouts of America. We will uphold the standards of conduct expected.
